

You have called your children, to this cleansing water, that they may share in the faith of your Church and have eternal life.

By the mystery of this consecrated water lead them to a new and spiritual birth.

We ask this through Christ our Lord.

The two disciples recounted what had taken place on the way, and how Jesus was made known to them in the breaking of bread.

While they were still speaking about this, he stood in their midst and said to them. "Peace be with you." But they were startled and terrified and thought that they were seeing a ghost. Then he said to them, "Why are you troubled? And why do questions arise in your hearts? Look at my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me and see, because a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you can see I have." And as he said this. he showed them his hands and his feet. While they were still incredulous for joy and were amazed, he asked them, "Have you anything here to eat?" They gave him a piece of baked fish; he took it and ate it in front of them.

Pray, brethren (brothers and sisters), that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father.


May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church.


The Priest concludes the Preface with the people, singing:

Lord Jesus Christ... ... Who live and reign for ever and ever.



behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.



Reaching our stretch goal reduces the monthly amount we owe to the Archdiocese and allows your Sunday contributions to do more here.
