Penitential Act


I confess to almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do,

At the words that follow, up to and including and became man, all bow. and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man.



Amen.


The Eucharistic Prayer

Lift up your hearts. We lift them up to the Lord.




The Priest concludes the Preface with the people, singing:

May we your holy people dedicate our lives as firm disciples of Jesus Christ, Son of God and Son of Mary, wherever we go.


